Section 2 Senior Weeds Officer's Report

ITEM 8.1: Senior Weeds Officers Report – February to March 2017

During this reporting period I have attended one MVWAC, one NWRWC, one public meeting at Grawin held by the North West Plains Sustainability Group (the Landcare Group) on Hudson Pear, two public consultation meetings on the new Biosecurity Act, one at Walgett and one at Lightning Ridge. We also attended the Coonabarabran Show on Friday 10th and Saturday 11th March with the MVWAC Weeds Display trailer. One very refreshing thing to come out of the Grawin meeting was that a landholder spoke at the end of the meeting taking ownership of the pear on his property and the waste of time that it was sitting in meetings waiting for handouts to help with what in turn is his responsibility. It is a shame more people (including associations don't share his views).

There is a letter being sent out to General Managers from DPI regarding training for the new Biosecurity Act. I believe they will require Weeds Officers to complete ten, two hour online modules and two days face-to-face training before the 1st July which is when the act will come into force. Unfortunately most of our officers don't have access to computers and will need to travel to Walgett to complete the training.

We carried out 3 interviews for the position of a Weeds Control Officer within the Walgett Shire. The successful applicant will commence employment with Council for the Walgett Shire on Tuesday 4th April.

Madeira Vine was identified in Yearian Creek Reserve after a report by a member of the public. It covers approximately an acre of land in the creek and typically climbs trees and covers the ground. The vine is found mostly near the coast, I had not seen it before in the County area. As it is an LLS Reserve it will be controlled by LLS.

We are going to Lightning Ridge in the last week of May to carry out work for DPI - Lands on a contract basis in areas they have designated.

Summary:

The purpose of this report is to provide Council with a summary of inspections that have been conducted over the period of February to March 2017 on private property, reserves, travelling stock routes, high risk watercourses and rail corridors.

Overview:

A total of 113 inspections were recorded throughout the combined Shires of Coonamble, Gilgandra, Walgett, Warren and Warrumbungle's with a total inspected area of 9,623.11ha. The bulk inspections were conducted in Warrumbungle's with a total of 53 undertaken. 23 were undertaken in Coonamble and 33 inspections conducted in Gilgandra.

Out of the 113 properties that were inspected only 16 properties had no visible weeds infestations sighted. A total of 97 properties were identified to have weed incursions. Inspectorial staff had the opportunity to engage with numerous landholders regarding their obligations and responsibilities as landholders to control the growth of these species.

Overview:

A total of 99 infestations were recorded throughout the combined Shires of Coonamble, Gilgandra, Walgett, Warren and Warrumbungle's with a total infested area of 693.96ha. The majority of the weeds identified were mature size plants with the bulk infestations being recorded in the Warrumbungle Shire. Blackberry was the main weed incursion found with a total area of 294.75ha in Warrumbungle's, followed by 224ha infested with African Boxthorn which was only found in Coonamble. In Gilgandra there was multiple weed species found with the bulk being tiger pear with a total of 80ha infested.
